# **COUNTY COUNCIL MATTERS**

## WORCESTERSHIRE ON DEMAND UPDATE

Following extensive pressure from myself and Cllr Tom Wells WCC have agreed that from 6th of Jan following locations will become live. Taylors Lane The Firs

Ledbury

Malvern Science Park

Barnards Green.

In the future, WCC are going to look at the Hospital and Haresfield House, which is the main doctors surgery for Kempsey. But no date has been set as to when these will come live.

It is also hoped that during 2025 part of the Wychavon area will be included.

In addition, following my Motion in full council on the 07/11/24, it has been agreed that from 06/01/2025 all Veterans and Service Personnel living in the Worcestershire On Demand Bus Zone will be able to have the same concession that pensioners have, i.e. free travel after 0930.

This has been a very long campaign I have fought against the ruling administration, and I am absolutely delighted that finally the veterans in Worcestershire will get more than hot air and warm words.



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## RYALL EAST QUARY APPLICATION & RIPPLE SCHOOL LANE QUARY FOR MINERALS APPLICATION (CEMEX)

I have been talking to an Officer in WCC who is dealing with these planning applications. Cemex have been asked to provide more information, the earliest the application can now come before the planning committee at County Hall is February.

### **TRAFFICE ROAD ORDERS**

I understand that the legal team at WCC who deal with TRO's is now very understaffed and this has continued to delay any applications for double yellow lines or other road legal applications.

#### SWDP-R UPDATE oct

We are still waiting for WCC to complete the work on Transport, it needs to be in by December.

Subject to WCC getting this done it is expected that the hearing with the Planning Inspectors will take place now in late February, it is expected to take three weeks.

Once that hearing is completed, the SWDPR will gain considerable weight.

### 70 HOMES AT THE MARINA/HOLLY GREEN oct

70 Homes on the A4104 at Holly Green – As I said last month I still have no more news when this will come before the Southern Area Planning Committee.

### LAND AT HOLLY GREEN FOR 27 HOMES AND 1 X SHOP oct

I still have no more news; this is progressing through the planning process.

### FURROW CLOSE

The planning appeal decision is expected to be issued on or before 21<sup>st</sup> November 2024.
